Things to bring to ROS:

Staff will search all property including suitcases, purses and clothing. Do not bring any food or drinks. Clients are assigned small cubbies to organize a limited amount of clothing and other items. If the cubby or the closet gets overcrowded, staff will require clothes to be sent home or donated.

Basket for hair accessories
 2 – 4 small framed pictures
 Up to 10 loose photos

Hair products	Brush, hairdryer
Deodorant	Tooth paste
Make-up	Toothbrush
Lotion	

Night gown or pants/shirt	5 or 6 at most
Shorts	8 Underwear 8 to 10
T-shirts	10 Socks 8 to 10
Sweat pants	4 or 5

Shoes (10):

- Dress 2
- Casual 3
- Tennis shoes 2
- Flip-flop 1
- Slippers 2

Closet – maximum of 14 hangers:

- Jeans 4 Shirts 5
- Slacks 5
- Coat 2
- Jacket 1

Do not bring
 anything tight or a top that will expose skin or slacks that are low-riders. Modesty is enforced. These types of clothes will be sent home. No sleeveless or see-through shirts are allowed.

REQUIRED ITEMS:

- A current LA ID or driver's license
- A social security card
- Medicaid card if you have one
- Medicaid denial letter or other proof that you have submitted an application
- Social Security Card

Do bring
 A book bag or backpack if you have one
 Pens, notebooks, paper

What is not allowed?

Do not bring

- Cigarettes, cell phone, music devices
- Food, drinks, sodas, or cookies
- Junk foods, candy, chips, or gum
- Over the counter medications
- Books, videos, magazines
- Photo albums
- Excessive new clothes
- Stamps or envelopes
- Bank cards
- Credit cards

If you are on prescription medication – you are required to bring at least a THIRTY day supply with you. Outside appointments are generally not allowed during initial eight weeks.

Do not bring
 Any narcotic medication. If you have a question about your medication, please call office. If you desire to come, and are on a habit forming medication, ask your doctor to change it to non-narcotic before you come.

ROS will provide generic hygiene items if client does not have any. We also provide bedding, sheets, towels, pillows, laundry detergent. YOU MAY NOT BRING THESE ITEMS FROM HOME.

NO CASH ACCEPTED -- Check or money order, must be payable to Rays of Sonshine with client's name in the memo line. This may be given to staff during family support meetings or Mail to P.O. Box 7299 Monroe, LA 71211. Address envelope to Rays of Sonshine in care of the client.
